1. Background

The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) is the apex-level institution for disaster management in India. The Disaster Management Act, 2005 provides for setting up the NDMA along with a host of other institutions at the national, state, and district levels. Chaired by the Prime Minister, the NDMA is mandated to lay down the policies, plans and guidelines for disaster management, and implement various programmes related to various aspects of disaster management. Since its inception, NDMA has taken several initiatives and programmes in strengthening disaster preparedness and mitigation, improving disaster response and recovery, and supporting capacity-building activities in the country.

2. Job Description.

Working within the Mitigation Division, the young consultants will assist the Member and Advisor, Mitigation to initiate/implement various programmes related to disaster/Mitigation subject.

4. Key Tasks and Responsibilities/Outline of the Tasks to be carried out:

- i. Follow up with states on NDMF/SDMF projects
- ii. To prepare and submit a detailed project implementation chart with segregation of project activities on a monthly basis.
- iii. To coordinate and liaise with the stakeholders on a weekly basis for smooth implementation of the project and monitor the progress with respect to project activities.
- iv. To assist Mitigation Division NDMA, in liaison with implementing agency for smooth implementation of various activities.
- v. To assist Mitigation Division NDMA to conduct workshops, capacity building programmes and other related activities.
- vi. To assist for conducting meeting, preparing minutes for the assigned subject and any other subject if required.
- vii. To assist the Mitigation Division of NDMA in ensuring timely release of funds for the respective projects/programmes.
- viii. To generate/compile reports on the progress of the project deliverables as required.
- ix. Organize the meetings of the project monitoring committee of projects and follow up on its recommendations.
- x. Any other work that may be considered necessary for overall support of the Mitigation Division.

- An annual report summarizing the achievements, challenges, and recommendations for concerned subject

6. Duty station: New Delhi, India

The young consultant will be based at NDMA, New Delhi and is required to travel to field locations, as necessary, to support intervention implementation and monitoring.

7. Status (Full time/Part Time/Short term or Long-term): Full Time. It is a full-time engagement and young Consultant shall not take up any other assignment during the period of consultancy with NDMA).

Young Consultants will be engaged for maximum of 2 years with no further extension, However, their continuation of their position beyond the first year, would be contingent on a satisfactory Annual Performance Review based on clearly defined Key Performance Indicators. Hence the Initial appointment of long term Young Consultants to be 1 year, continuity from year to year will be based the Appraisal report by Divisional Head. No fresh approval from Admn Division will be required. However in case of adverse report by divisional head, the appointment will be discontinued with the approval of Member Secretary NDMA.

13. Support/inputs to be provided by NDMA to facilitate Consultancy: During the consultancy no additional support other than office equipment i.e. Desktop, Printers, Internet etc. may be provided by NDMA.
